



Alma Mater International School top achievers

Alma Mater is very proud to announce the following Cambridge Examination results. Students have the option to write a number of exams ranging from the International General Certificate in Secondary Education (IGCSE) and Advanced Subsidiary Level (AS Level) to Advanced Level (A Level/Post Matric).

The IGCSE group of 58 students achieved a staggering 35 As, 74 As and 93 Bs. This means that 35 students' marks fall within the top 5% of the world who wrote this exam. To put this into perspective: Cambridge IGCSE is the world's most popular international qualification for 14 to 16 year olds. It is taken in over 145 countries and in more than 6,100 schools around the world (<http://www.cie.org.uk/about-us/facts-and-figures/>).

Three IGCSE students achieved seven As: Mia Bekker (5 As and 2 As), Sagitta Mulder (3 As and 4 As) and Clio Matthews (2 As and 5 As). Two students achieved six As each: Michelle Weinmann (3 As and 3 As) and Pretty Maloma (1 A and 5 As). Students with five As: Michael Forrester (3 As and 2 As), Zoe Bean (One A and 4 As), Simone Brand (One A and 4 As), Dimpho Ndlovu (5 As) and Eugene Luyke (5 As).

The AS Level group of 24 students achieved a total of 25 distinctions and 13 Bs. Anine Steyn (two distinctions), Izel Ogras (two distinctions) and Ruben Luus (one distinction) achieved a complete Matric with Exemption and that in their 11th year. These students will pursue their A Levels in their Grade 12 year. It is an extraordinary achievement and we can't wait to see their A Level results at the end of 2017. The top AS Level student is Megan Holtzhausen who achieved four distinctions and one B.
